


# Abnormal Psychology



Abnormal psychology is the branch of psychology that studies unusual patterns of behavior, emotion and thought, which may or may not be understood as abnormal. Abnormal psychology is a division of psychology that studies people who are "abnormal" or "atypical" compared to the members of a given society. The definition of abnormal psychology is a branch of psychology that deals with psychopathology and abnormal behavior, often in a clinical context. The term abnormal psychology refers to the study and treatment of those mental and emotional disorders that interfere with a person's ability to feel themselves and carry out their daily activities. Abnormal psychology deals with behaviors that are considered negative or harmful, rather than abnormal in the sense that they simply veer from the normal. Abnormal psychology studies deviant behavior. How are certain behaviors identified as abnormal? What is abnormality? How do psychologists study abnormality? In this lesson, we will define abnormal psychology, look at two theories to explain abnormal psychology definition is - a branch of psychology concerned with mental and emotional disorders (such as neuroses, psychoses, and schizophrenia).
